



## TSQHA POINT NOMINATION RULES

1. Point nominations are valid only after association dues have been paid.
2. A nomination form must be filled out, with proper fees enclosed and mailed out to the designated person as stipulated on the form.
3. Nominations must be postmarked prior to the date of the first show in which points are to be tabulated. Nominations post marked the date of a particular show will not be accepted for that show but will be tabulated for all subsequent shows.
4. At a show, nominations can **only** be accepted by the TSQHA Show Secretary, and must be turned in prior to the showing of the exhibitor's first class of the day for points to count for that show.
5. Only points earned at TSQHA and TSQHA-approved shows will count, and no points will count until both membership and nomination fees have been paid.
6. It will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor or owner to provide documented proof of payment of dues and nomination fees, if requested to validate any discrepancies.
7. Year-end awards are given to fifth place and only to horses earning a minimum of **twenty (20)** points in a given class **AND HORSES SHOWING 8 TSQHA SHOWS/8 JUDGES.**

8. The **Open, Amateur, Amateur Select and Youth All Around** must earn a minimum of **twenty (20)** points in at least **three (3)** or more categories to qualify for any all around awards.

### AWARDS GIVEN

- A. All halter and performance classes as shown on the TSQHA-sponsored show bill.
- B. ALL AROUND and RESERVE ALL AROUND in **Open, Amateur, Select, Youth 14-18, Youth 13 and Under.**
- C. GRAND and RESERVE CHAMPIONS in each sex division of Halter (combined age divisions).
- D. HIGH POINT and RESERVE HIGH POINT Novice Amateur and Novice Youth.
- E. HIGH POINT and RESERVE HIGH POINT Small-Fry

9. All ties will be broken according to the TSQHA By-Laws, Article IX, Section 4.
10. Points will only be awarded to nominated horses. Points will follow the horse, not the rider, with the exception of Leadline and Small Fry Exhibitors. Points shall be based on the rider alone for the Leadline and Small Fry Divisions. Leadline and Small Fry Exhibitors need to be nominated, not the horse.
11. All TSQHA association-held shows are **triple pointed**.
12. In the event the Select and Amateur classes are combined, then the exhibitor would get the points posted to the SELECT division (based on total number of entries in the class).  
In the event the classes were NOT combined and an exhibitor elects to show in the Amateur class, then the points would post to the Amateur Division.  
For all non-select classes (like halter, western riding, hunter hack, etc.), the points would be posted to the Amateur Division.
